TRIP DETAILS AND INFORMATION

Who? — The trip is limited to 18 persons. Most everyone traveling will be connected to either a Church of the Brethren congregation or Camp Swatara.

What? — A 10 day travel trip that includes travel, all accommodations, all breakfasts, all dinners while in Maine and most fees and ticket costs.

When? — The trip departs from Camp Swatara on the morning of Sept. 9 and returns on Sept. 18. Transportation will be in two camp 12 passenger vans with an enclosed trailer for luggage. Overnight lodging en-route will likely be in Massachusetts northbound and in Connecticut traveling home.

Where will we stay? — While in Maine lodging is in waterfront cottages that are modern and comfortable. Views are of the awe-inspiring coves and bays of Mt. Desert Island from a private shoreline. Each cottage has either 2 or 3 private bedrooms, a shared bathroom, and a fully equipped kitchen and living room.

Where will we eat? — While in Maine, breakfast is served buffet style each morning. Dinners usually happen as a group either at the cottages or at a local restaurant. Time is provided to stop at a local grocery store to pick up personally desired food for lunches and snacks.

Why? — This is an opportunity to travel with friendly people and knowledgeable leaders to a breathtaking part of creation. Each day includes opportunities for touring, relaxing, and reflecting with moments for devotion.


How? — *How much does it cost?* \$975.⁰⁰ depending on final cost of accommodations for 2016.
