

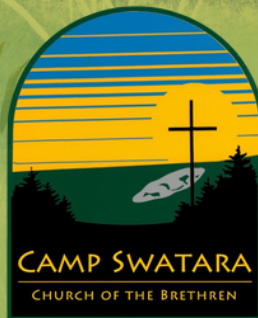

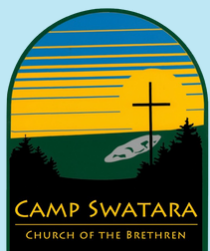

Families impacted by incarceration may also receive scholarships through our Dallas SCI Scholarship Fund.

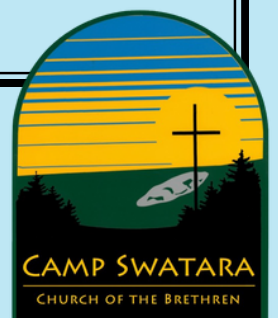

Our counselors are NOT provided behavioral health training, therefore, we are currently unable to accommodate campers with significant behavioral needs. Because of Camp's rustic environment and natural setting, all Monarch campers must be able to move freely around Camp without the assistance of wheelchairs, crutches, or walkers. Campers must be able to move from activity to activity without much difficulty. Please do not hesitate to contact Camp with any further questions or concerns.

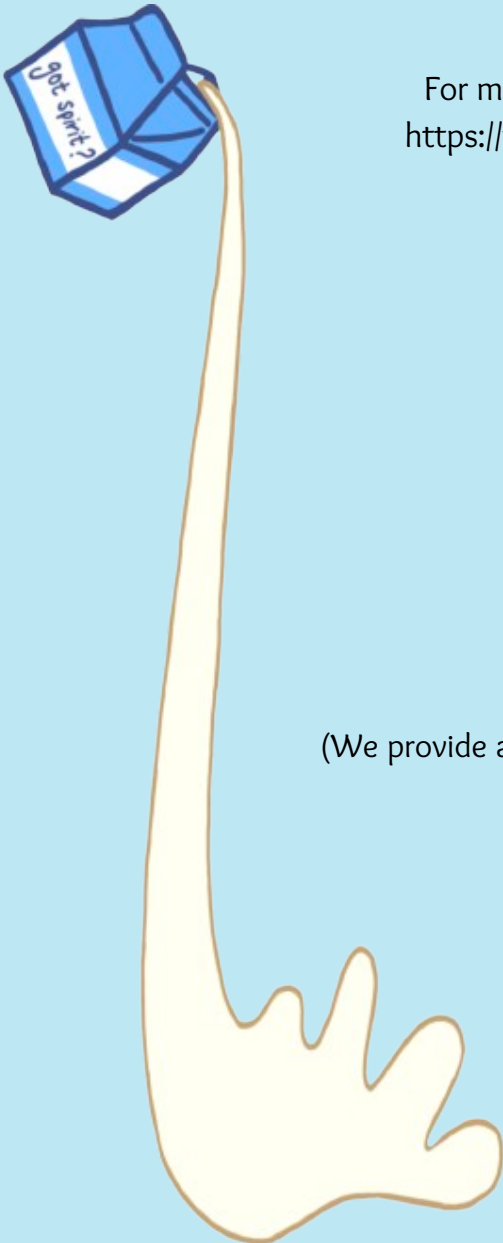
